



Limon School District Master Planning Community Update

Limon School District RE-4J is going through a master planning process to plan for the future of the school district. Community involvement is needed!

Current Status:

We have hired The Neenan Company to guide us through the master planning process. A master plan is a thorough, thoughtful analysis of the school district facilities which identifies the strengths that can be built on as well as the weaknesses and deficiencies that could be improved. This will provide a tool for the administration, staff, and community to make educated decisions about existing school facilities like whether the existing buildings should be renovated, replaced, or added onto now and in the future.

A master plan is produced through a team effort involving school administration, staff, students, community members and professional consultants. The master planning process includes visits from professional consultants and engineers to assess the suitability of our current school buildings. It will also include staff and community meetings to ask for opinions about what currently works well at the school and what can be improved.

We will be working on the master plan from now until January 2012, so we will need your support!
